Lignier is one of the legendary producers in Morey St. Denis. His wines are dark and ripe, but have a deep earthiness and minerality that give the wines great balance. Morey St. Denis lies at the crossroads of rusticity and finesse and are some of the finest representations of Pinot Noir in the Cote de Nuits.

BIDDING
